

# *2010 Seattle Book and Paper Show*

*May 22nd & 23rd  
Seattle Center Exhibition Hall*

The Producers of the Seattle Antiquarian Book Fair and Book Arts Show are presenting the 2nd Annual Seattle Book & Paper Show at the Seattle Center Exhibition Hall on Saturday and Sunday, May 22nd and 23rd, 2010 and invite you to join us.

This year we are reaching out to the book community at large to help fill the void left with the demise of the Northwest Bookfest in 2003. The show promoters, area booksellers David Gregor and Louis Collins, have successfully produced the annual Seattle Antiquarian Book Fair since 1997, which is considered the best regional antiquarian book fair in the country. Louis and David plan to expand the show to include sellers of new books, book publishers, and small presses in addition to sellers of used and collectible books, book artists, print sellers, and map dealers. The producers have a twelve-year track record of providing a successful venue for booksellers and they want to bring back a touch of the old Northwest Bookfest. We invite you to join us in May 2010.

This show will be a streamlined version of the October Antiquarian Book Fair. There will be no carpet, and no pipe and drape. We will rent a 10' by 10' space for \$295.00. No furnishings come with the space. Exhibitors will be able to bring their own tables, grid walls, bookcases, etc. Or, exhibitors may rent from the Producers: tables undraped and draped, folding bookcases, glass cases, trophy cases, grid walls, chairs, and electricity. Load-in and set up will be on Friday May 21st from Noon to 8 pm. The show will open to the public on Saturday from 10 am to 6 pm and on Sunday from 11 am to 4 pm.

The May show will receive the same extensive advertising as the October Book Fair. With the inclusion of a more diverse selection of sellers we hope to reach a larger book, print and paper audience. Given the shifting landscape of west coast regional fairs, we strongly believe that the greater northwest region can support a book, print and paper show, and we welcome your participation.
